

Washington, DC – Today, Rep. Ben Ray Luján highlighted funding for law enforcement in communities throughout the 3rd Congressional District. The funding will be distributed by the Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program under the United States Bureau of Justice Assistance. The funding will be made available through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act. In total, New Mexico is eligible to receive over \$18 million for local law enforcement.

“Justice Assistance Grant funding provided by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act will help fight crime and keep law enforcement on the streets,” said Rep. Luján. “Funding for the Justice Assistance Grant Program helps train and equip law enforcement, keeping them safe and helping them protect our communities.”

JAG funding provides law enforcement with valuable resources for prosecution and court programs; prevention and education programs; community corrections programs; drug treatment and enforcement programs; planning, evaluation, and technology improvement programs; and crime victim and witness programs.

Communities must apply with the U.S. Department of Justice in order to receive JAG funding.
