- USDA-Rural Development has a home loan and grant program to help offset the cost of home repairs, including heating and water systems. The program is available to very low-income residents who own and occupy a home in need of repairs.
- Rural Development also has resources available to support water systems, such as municipal systems and mutual domestic water associations, in communities of 10,000 or less. These water systems can apply for USDA's regular loans and grants or Emergency Community Water Assistance Grants if they have current environmental and engineering documents.
- Communities with populations less than 20,000 can also apply for USDA loans and grants to repair community infrastructure damaged by the storm.

- The Mortgage Finance Authority can provide a range of resources to residents affected by the storm.

- The homeowner rehabilitation program provides assistance to low-income homeowners who lack the resources to make necessary repairs to their homes. Assistance can be used for reimbursement of costs for rehabilitation, which includes the following: applicable codes, standards or ordinances, rehabilitation standards, essential improvements, energy-related improvements, lead-based paint hazard reduction, accessibility for disabled persons, repair or replacement of major housing systems, incipient repairs and general property improvements of a non-luxury nature, site improvements and utility connections.

- MFA relies on nonprofits, housing authorities, and local governments to administer the homeowner rehabilitation program.
